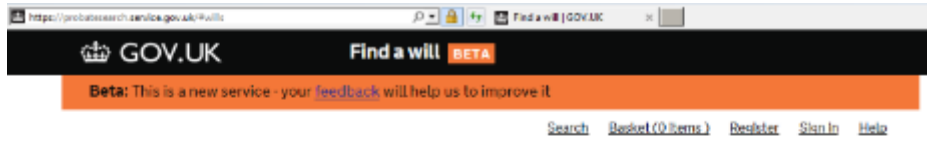

OBITUARY NOTICES.

It is with much regret that we have to record the death of Miss J. E. LINTER, who had been a member of the Society since the year 1895.

Of a retiring disposition Miss Linter did not attend the meetings of the Society, and consequently was not known personally to many of the members. She was, however, an enthusiastic collector, and her cabinets contained very many rare and interesting species, more especially of land shells. Many of these came from the collections made in India by W. Theobald and Colonel Skinner.

It is understood that her collection has been bequeathed to the Devon and Exeter Museum on condition that it would be accessible to the public.

Miss Linter was born at Teignmouth in the year 1844, and her death occurred at her residence, Saville House, Twickenham, on August 30th, 1909.
