#### **What do we mean by communicating about your project?**

- Issuing Press Releases
- Press interviews either in a verbal (video and audio) or written format
- Production or contribution to all print or online written content e.g. articles, case studies etc.,
- Website content, including blogs
- Social media content
- Talking/ presenting at events e.g. PowerPoint presentations, talks and speeches, private views

#### **How do I acknowledge the project?**

Where possible, the following acknowledgement statement should be used:

*‘This work is part of the Rebuilding the Foundations – Gloucestershire’s Museums project, delivered by South West Museum Development, funded by National Lottery Heritage Fund and Arts Council England. The project supports museums in Gloucestershire to critically examine and improve their approaches to audience development and volunteer involvement’*
